This award is presented to recognize outstanding high school mentors who have consistently motivated students to strive for higher achievement. Nominations for award recipients will be accepted by the Department's American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) Student Chapter Council. Nominations will be made by students currently enrolled in Chemical Engineering at the University of Arkansas and will identify a team contact who will be responsible for contacting the nominee and securing their willingness to stand for the award.

Nomination packages will include an essay about how the nominee has influenced or motivated students to strive for success; brief biographical information should be included when pertinent. Nominations should be limited to 750 words and should include specific examples of how the nominee influenced or motivated students.

Nominations are due by 15 November for awards to be made in the following year. Awardees will be determined by the Department's AIChE Council by 1 December. A maximum of three awardees will be chosen each year. Awards will be presented at the Annual Spring Departmental Banquet by the nominating team. Awardees will be ineligible for re-nomination for two years (so that a winner at the 2002 Banquet would be eligible for re-nomination for the 2005 Banquet).
